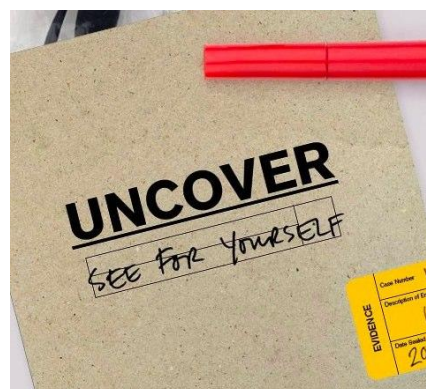

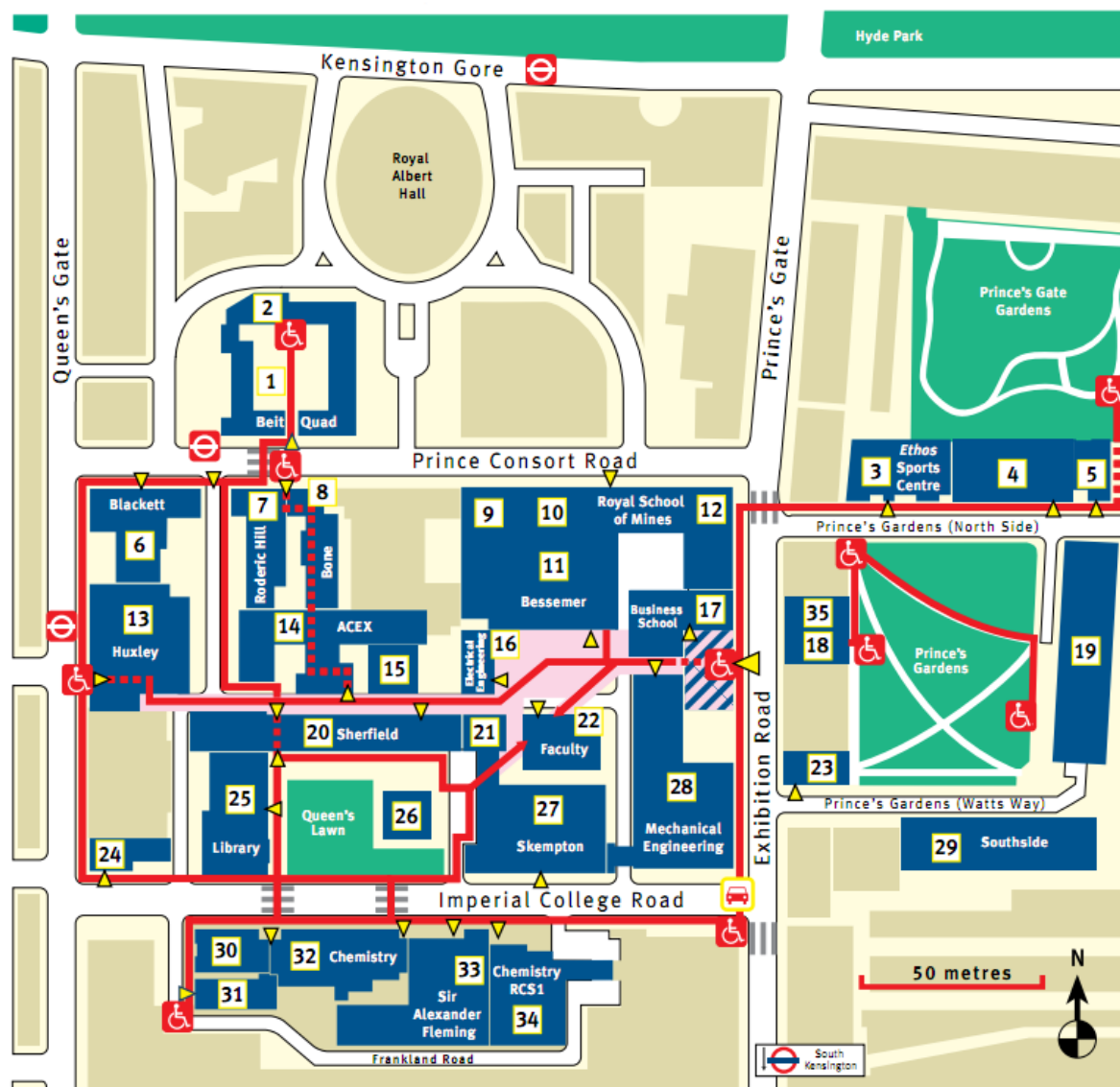
Venues to be confirmed – look out for emails
